STEM Career Apprenticeship Program FAQs:

What will students do?	Entry level professional work in field or industry of interest: healthcare, IT, manufacturing, engineering, and more.
When will students work?	 5 - 8 weeks full-time in the summer (6 hours per day, 5 days per week). Students and employer are welcome to explore continued part-time employment into the school year, after high school graduation, and beyond.
What is expected of the employer?	 Create a welcoming, inclusive, educational environment where students can learn, grow, and explore their interests. Provide meaningful work and projects. Mentor students and help them grow professionally.
What does the company contribute financially?	 \$10-\$12/hour paid directly to the student. Students will save at least half for college. Tax-deductible contribution to the scholarship fund (\$2000 suggested). Scholarships are awarded to selected Carmen graduates upon college enrollment.
Benefits to corporate partners:	 Diversify your workplace and develop a pipeline of talent for critical roles. Provide mentoring and development opportunities for your staff. Partner with a strong local educational organization to open the door to college and careers for young people in Milwaukee. Assist talented students with future education expenses.
